CORPORATE AND ECONOMY NEWS

- Wipro: The company will acquire LeanSwift Solutions for \$21 million in an all-cash deal. The deal is expected to be completed by March 2022. Besides, the technology major has entered into a partnership with Italy-based UMPI, a smart lighting and building products maker, who will use the Wipro Sewage Monitor to empower water companies, municipalities in Europe.
- Vodafone Idea: The telco is reportedly targeting a four-fold jump in annual capital expenditure to \$2 billion, the company's top management has said, as it looks to take on stronger rivals.
- **Cipla:** Entered agreement to acquire up to 33% partnership interest in Clean Max Auriga Power LLP to enhance the share of renewable power source in its operation and to comply with regulatory requirements for being a 'captive user' under electricity laws.
- Auto stocks: Ratings agency Icra Ltd has revised lower growth forecast for the domestic passenger vehicles industry to 8-11% for the current fiscal from the earlier projected 14-17% due to chip shortages. For the two-wheeler segment, it said volumes are expected to contract 1-4% in FY22 against an earlier prediction of 6-8% growth.
- Sun Pharma: Its subsidiary has received final approval from US FDA for its abbreviated new drug application (ANDA) for generic Amphotericin B Liposome for injection. As per October IQVIA Health data, AmBisome Liposome for Injection, 50mg/vial, had annualized sales of about \$136 million in the US.
- **PSU banks:** Employees of several state-owned banks including the State Bank of India will go on a two-day strike starting today. The United Forum of Bank Unions (UFBU), which is an umbrella body of 9 bank unions has called the strike to protest the government's decision to privatise several public sector leaders.
- Indiabulls Housing Finance: The company's founder is nearing a deal to sell about half his stake in the shadow lender to investors led by Blackstone Group Inc. and Abu Dhabi Investment Authority, as the sector comes out of a three-year meltdown.
- Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone: Has signed a share purchase agreement with Adani Transmission for divestment of 100% equity stake of MPSEZ Utilities.
- Yes Bank: The private sector lender has filed a petition in a Mumbai company court against the family promoters of Dish TV India Ltd saying it fears that a lawsuit could be brought against the bank, limiting it from voting at Dish TV's annual general meeting (AGM) on 30 December.
- ICICI Bank: RBI has imposed a penalty of Rs.30 lakh on ICICI Bank for deficiencies in regulatory compliance, and another Rs.1.8 crore on Punjab National Bank. ICICI Bank was found in not complying directions related to levy of charges for non-maintenance of minimum balance in saving accounts. PNB was found in contravention of RBI provisions relating to pledge of shares.
- **Reliance Industries:** CCI approves acquisition of 40% shareholding in Sterling and Wilson Renewable Energy Ltd. by Reliance New Energy Solar Ltd.
- Jubilant Industries: Company's wholly owned material subsidiary, Jubilant Agri and Consumer Products Ltd. has restarted manufacturing operations at its Sahibabad plant in compliance with orders issued by the CAQM.
- Future Enterprises: Commercial papers of the company converted into Working Capital Term Loan since it opted for one-time restructuring. Therefore, rating of commercial papers moved to 'IVR D' (Issuer not cooperating category).
- Fed signals three rate hikes: The Federal Reserve said on Wednesday it would end its pandemic-era bond purchases in March and pave the way for three quarterpercentage-point interest rate hikes by the end of 2022 as the economy nears full employment and the US central bank copes with a surge of inflation.

Global Market Update

Wall Street ended sharply higher on Wednesday after the US Federal Reserve said it would end its pandemic-era bond purchases in March as it exits from policies enacted at the start of the health crisis. For the session, the Dow Jones Industrial Average rose 1.08% to end at 35,927.43 while the S&P 500 gained 1.63% to 4,709.85. The Nasdaq Composite climbed 2.15% to 15,565.58.

Crude Oil

Oil prices rose on Thursday as the US implied consumer petroleum demand surged to a record high in the world's top oil consumer even as the Omicron variant of the coronavirus threatens to dent oil consumption globally.

SGX Nifty: Trends on SGX Nifty indicate a positive opening for the index in India with an 82-point gain. The Nifty futures were trading at 17,333.50 on the Singaporean Exchange at around 07:20 hours IST.
