- Bharti Airtel Q2FY21 Result(QoQ): Revenue up 7.7% to Rs 25,785 crore. Net loss narrows to Rs 763 crore from Rs 15,933 crore. Ebitda up 11.3% to Rs 11,848 crore. Ebitda margin at 46% from 44.4%. ARPU improves to Rs 162 from Rs 157.India business revenue up 7.4% to Rs 13,832 crore. Africa business revenue up 11% to Rs 7,166 crore. Digital TV Services revenue flat at Rs 755 crore. Tower services revenue up 7.5% to Rs 1,766 crore.
- Tata Motors Q2FY21 Result(YoY): Revenue down 18% to Rs 53,530 crore. Net loss widens to Rs 314 crore from Rs 217 crore. Ebitda down 21% to Rs 5,691 crore Ebitda margin at 10.6% from 10.9%. JLR retail sales down 11.9% to 1,13,569 units; up 53.3% quarter-on-quarter. JLR positive free cash flow of 463 million pounds. Continue to expect positive free cash flow over the second half. PV business achieved Ebitda breakeven.
- Castrol India Q3CY20 Result(YoY): Revenue up 4% to Rs 883.1 crore. Net profit up 9% to Rs 204.6 crore. Ebitda up 18% to Rs 288.2 crore. Ebitda margin at 32.6% from 28.8%. Declares interim dividend of Rs 2.5 per share. Record date for interim dividend set as November 6.
- Nippon Life India AMC Q2FY21 Result(YoY): Revenue down 13.8% to Rs 258.7 crore. Net profit up 6.2% to Rs 145.3 crore. Lower other expenses and employee costs aid profit growth.
- Other Results: ICICI Prudential Life Insurance(Mix), TV18 Broadcast(Good).
- Hero MotoCorp: Announces agreements with Harley-Davidson for the Indian market. The company will sell and service Harley motorcycles and sell parts & accessories through network of Harley dealers and its existing dealership network. It will also develop and sell a range of premium motorcycles under the Harley-Davidson brand name.
- ICICI Bank: The United States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) has
 concluded its investigation into the bank's loan impairment provisions under US
 GAAP and that the SEC does not intend to take any enforcement action against the
 lender.
- Cochin Shipyard: The company said it has inked a pact with Italy's Fincantieri for cooperation in areas like shipbuilding and ship repair. Fincantieri is one of the world's largest shipbuilding groups and a leader in diversification and innovation with over 230 years of history and more than 7,000 vessels built, operating 18 shipyards in four continents.
- **BPCL:** Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd (BPCL) on Tuesday launched a fully synthetic lubricant variant targeted at high-end motorcycles.
- ABFRL: Traders' body CAIT has raised objections over Aditya Birla Fashion and Retail's (ABFRL) plans to raise ₹1,500 crore by issuing 7.8% stake to Walmartowned Flipkart Group, alleging that the proposed deal violates the government's FDI policy.
- Lakshmi Vilas Bank: The proposed merger between Clix Capital and Lakshmi Vilas Bank (LVB) has run into delays over the provisioning of the bank's contingent liability of Rs.720 crore related to transactions involving former Religare promoters Malvinder and Shivinder Singh, according to a Mint report.
- Adani Gas: To consider raising up to \$400 million through foreign currency bonds on November 3.
- **Delta Corporation:** Sikkim casino operations to resume from November 1.

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DJIA and NASDAQ Composite

Stocks on Wall Street closed little changed on Tuesday, with the Dow and S&P 500 slipping on disappointing earnings and little hope for a U.S. coronavirus stimulus before Election Day, though the Nasdaq rose ahead of big technology company results. The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell 222.19 points, or 0.8%, to 27,463.19 and the S&P 500 lost 10.29 points, or 0.30%, to 3,390.68. The Nasdaq Composite added 72.41 points, or 0.64%, to 11,431.35.

Crude Oil

Crude rebounded on Tuesday as companies shut down some U.S. Gulf of Mexico oil production ahead of an approaching storm, although surging coronavirus infections and rising Libyan supply limited gains. Brent crude was up 58 cents, or 1.4 percent, at \$41.03 per barrel. U.S. oil gained \$1.01, or 2.6 percent, to settle at \$39.57 per barrel. Both contracts fell more than 3 percent on Monday.

SGX Nifty: Trends on SGX Nifty indicate a negative opening for the index in India with a 34 points loss. The Nifty futures were trading at 11853 on the Singaporean Exchange around 08:26 hours IST.

Bank Nifty opened gap up on Tuesday at 24288 made a high of 24810, made a low of 23924, and closed on a positive note at 24769 levels. For the day, support for Bank Nifty exists at 24400 and 24000 levels, whereas resistance for Bank Nifty stands at 25000 and 25200 levels.
